Tracking Progress In The National Health Priority Areas.

Abstract

The National Health Priority Performance Advisory Group (NHPPAG) is working with the National Health Priority Advisory Council on the specification and selection of strategic tracking indicators to measure performance in national health priority areas.

This presentation reviews the concept of strategic tracking indicators in the context of national health priority area activity, taking the initial indicators proposed for asthma as an example. It then goes on to describe NHPPAG proposals for the development of strategic tracking indicators in other health priority areas.
